
SOCIAL INCLUSION OF MIGRANTS

DESCRIPTION

our local partners as such. All analysis will focus on the problematics of refugees on education, employment, health, and housing as the four prior areas. The participants of the projects will create national action plan together with other NGO's, citizens and institutions with the help of our training course content and strategy plans right after when they go back to their countries.

OBJECTIVES

- To explore and understand the entire process that leads to social exclusion of refugees;
- -To identify the competences that young people can develop in connection with refugees and mobility;
- To develop methods of youth work that can contribute to combating exclusion of young migrants and radicalization of youth;
- To raise awareness on the topic of intercultural communication;
- To ensure immersive understanding of profile and social problems of refugees in Europe;
- To equip the participants with skills concerning dialogue, negotiation, mediation and tolerance;
- To teach basic tools in videography and to realize several video materials regarding the topic;
- To enable youth workers practice their skills and competences in the field of resolving conflicts.

TARGET GROUP

Social Inclusion of Migrants Project is directed to youth workers who are working with two types of target groups:

- 1. Youth with migrant background (asylum seekers, work immigrants, international volunteers, IDPs, etc.)
- 2. Youth in danger of radicalization, that is prone to demonstrating discriminative and intolerant approach towards groups with different cultural, ethnic, religious backgrounds.

The project will give opportunity for the experts to come together and discuss the current attempts of their national strategies, exchange of experience and best practices together with the new comers where they bring their passion, high motivation as well as unique contribution of YPIDA management team and trainers. We expect high level of outcomes form this dynamic harmony and become trigger towards the social inclusion matter.

RESPONSIBILITIES OF PARTNERS

- Each country will make a research and prepare a presentation on the number of refugees, life style, camps and/or other solutions.
- Each country is taking the full responsibility of implementing the national action plan in their community. The plan will be developed and decided during the project and more information will be given by then.

- Each country will bring clothes, food, drinks, and other materials for the intercultural night activity.
- Preparation of participants to the project, tickets, visa, and other logistical aspects with full cooperation with YPIDA is highly expected from the partner organizations.
- Each country will prepare video interview with refugees.

VIDEO-INTERVIEW WITH REFUGEES

Each country will prepare video interview with refugees. The short videos will be 3-5 min. and not focusing on the victims' aspect but more focusing on the inclusion problematic itself and if possible any solutions and/or proposals.

The questions for the interviews are:

- 1. How long you have been living here?
- 2. What is your opinion about European culture?
- 3. Are you planning to go back to your homeland when the war is over?
- 4. What is the most important problem you faced with through your stay here?
- 5. What are advantages and disadvantages of migrants in societies?

TECHNICAL INFORMATION

- The travel costs and other related costs will be reimbursed after the project when all necessary documents will be delivered to YPIDA. All necessary information will be given to participants during the project.
- In order to provide high quality conditions as well as technical field visits the project requires
 25 EURO participation fee.

- Please bring with you jackets and ready for windy seaside weather.
- Good humor and motivation is highly expected by the organizers.
- The currency of the hosting country is Turkish Lira. 1 EURO is approx. 4,1 TRY.


