

REFUGEES PROBLEM

We will define four priority areas concerning difficulties faced by refugees:
HOUSING
HEALTH
EDUCATION
EMPLOYMENT

NATIONAL ACTION PLAN

We will coordinate to find practical working solutions and develop projects indicating goals to be achieved for the areas mentioned

SIMULATION GAME

We will play a game in which you design and grow your own nation, with politics, customs, and an economy. We want to make you feel, not only understand the issues of migration politics. The game will culminate in a simulation on the topic, where you have the role of an envoy of your country.

STUDY VISITS

We will examine good practices and get information about the project topic from the authorized institutions. We will meet local NGOs to find out the ways in which the local methods deal with refugees and we will visit the Bundestag to see how German politics work.

Through non-formal education activities this project wants to increase your positive awareness of other cultures whilst supporting and promoting social inclusion of people from different backgrounds and cultures. It aims to prevent and combat prejudice, racism and all attitudes leading to exclusion, developing a sense of tolerance and understanding of diversity

COUNTRY PRESENTATIONS


We expect two things from you for country presentations;

- 1. Share one good and one bad practice concerning the integration of refugees.
- 2. Ask one of the following questions to a refugee or immigrant living in your city, ask the other one to a normal citizen, and take a video. The video interview should take place with at least 3 people.

For refugees: What would you need to enter the society? For citizens: What would you need to welcome foreigners into your society?

WORKSHOPS

Social inclusion, culture, angel and devil aspects of the media, discrimination, hate speech, active participation and more workshops that we prepared for you. We will share all the details in a timetable before the project.



OBJECTIVES OF THE PROJECT

- to explore and understand the entire process that leads to social exclusion of refugees;
- to identify the competences that young people can develop in connection with refugees and mobility;
- to raise awareness on the topic of intercultural communication;
- to ensure immersive understanding of profile and social problems of refugees;

- to equip the participants with skills concerning dialogue, negotiation, mediation and tolerance;
- to teach basic tools in videography and to realize several video materials regarding the topic;
- to enable youth workers practice their skills and competences in the field of resolving conflicts.

PARTICIPANTS' PROFILE

We expect the following criterias from our participants:

- aged between 22 and 33 years old;
- able to communicate in English;
- interested in the topics such as social inclusion, culture, policy, study visit, team working, creativity, media;
- competent enough to fulfill country presentations and cultural night activities;
- being ready to learn, share and practice;

- willing to participate in all activities in the program;
- able to formulate innovative solutions regarding housing, employment, education & health services and cultural & community programs for refugees;
- willing and able to change and to be changed.
