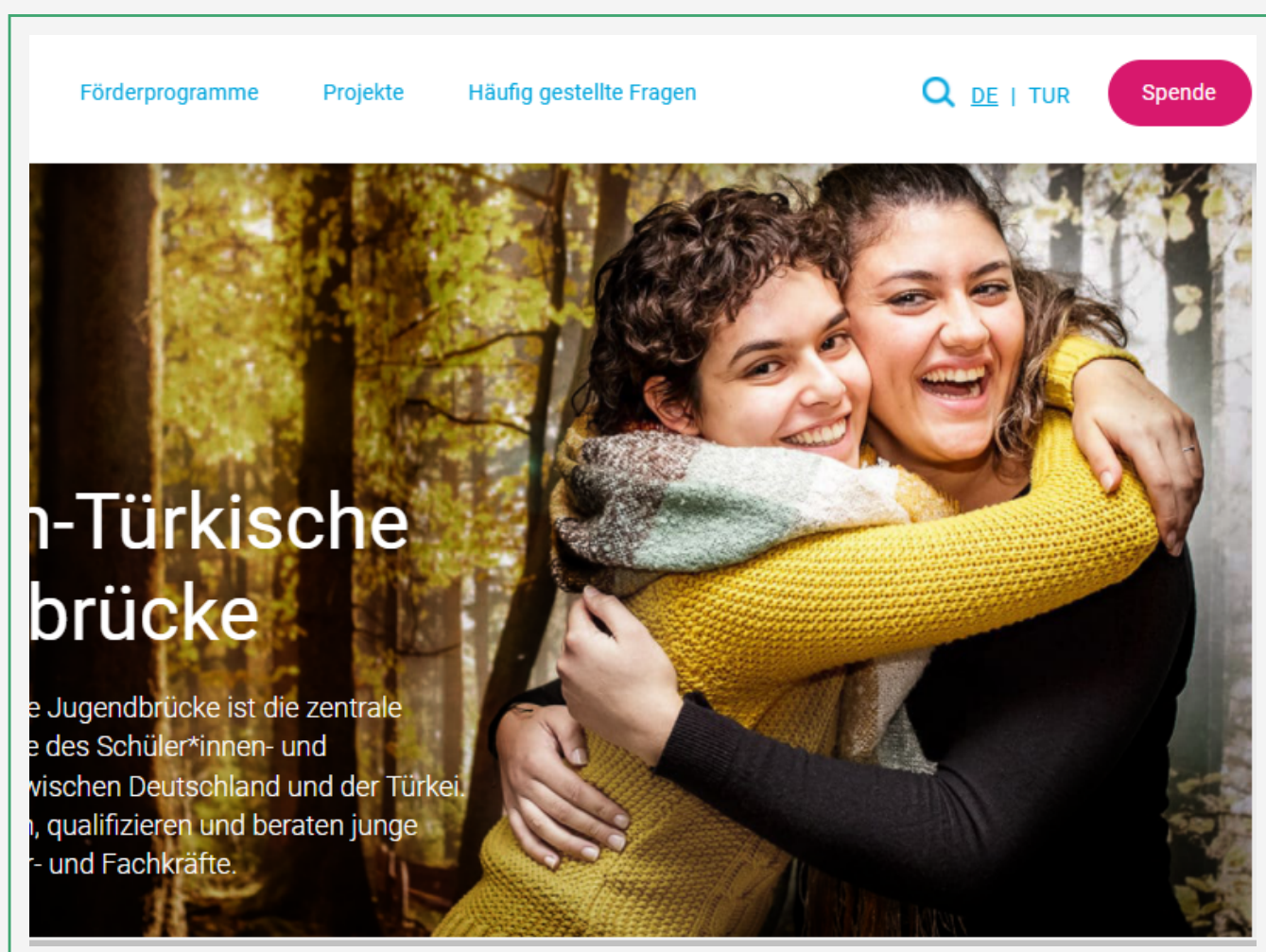

Context of the Project

We believe that digital youth work today is more critical than ever - we can use digital media and new technology to enhance youth work.

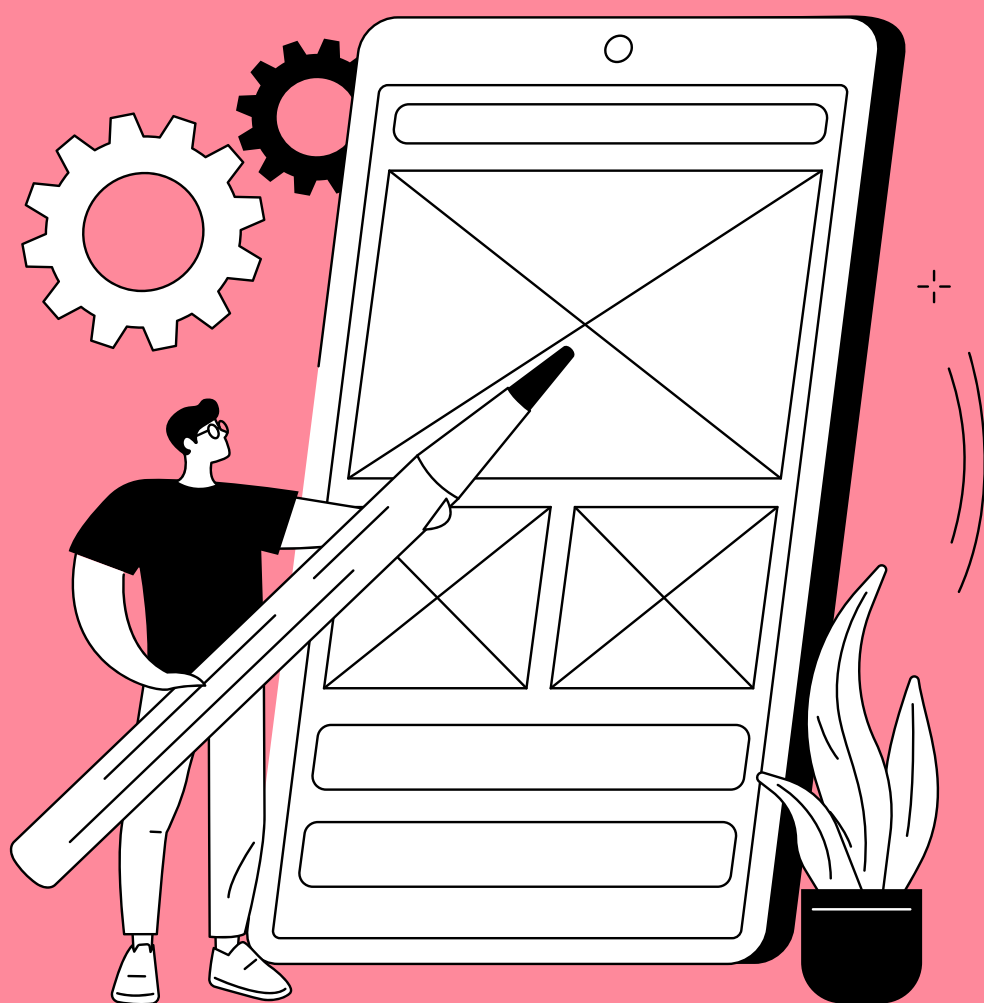
Aims and Objectives of the Project

- To develop the digital skills of youth workers using the media as auxiliary material, communication, learning, expressing the experience, and shaping the narrative with storytelling;
- To increase the knowledge of narrative conflicts of youth workers working in the conflict resolution field;
- To share good practises examples such as some German origin grant programs for young people, Erasmus+ Program and Youthpass Certificate with our participants;
- To encourage intercultural learning, dialogue and cooperation.

Methodology and Expected Results

The planned program includes a hybrid learning and practising method.

Accordingly, we will first meet online and conduct the workshops we have prepared for you. We will then expect you to do fieldwork in your localities to create your own stories. Finally, we will ask you to share the stories you have created with us in the online session.



#ENGAGE

We will engage through getting to know each other and team-building games, presentations and theoretical workshops, and the intercultural learning activities on online.



#CONNECT

We expect you to connect with your community through fieldwork to create a story.



#EMPOWER

We will share some of the keys and tips on disseminating and empowering the story you created in the last online session.

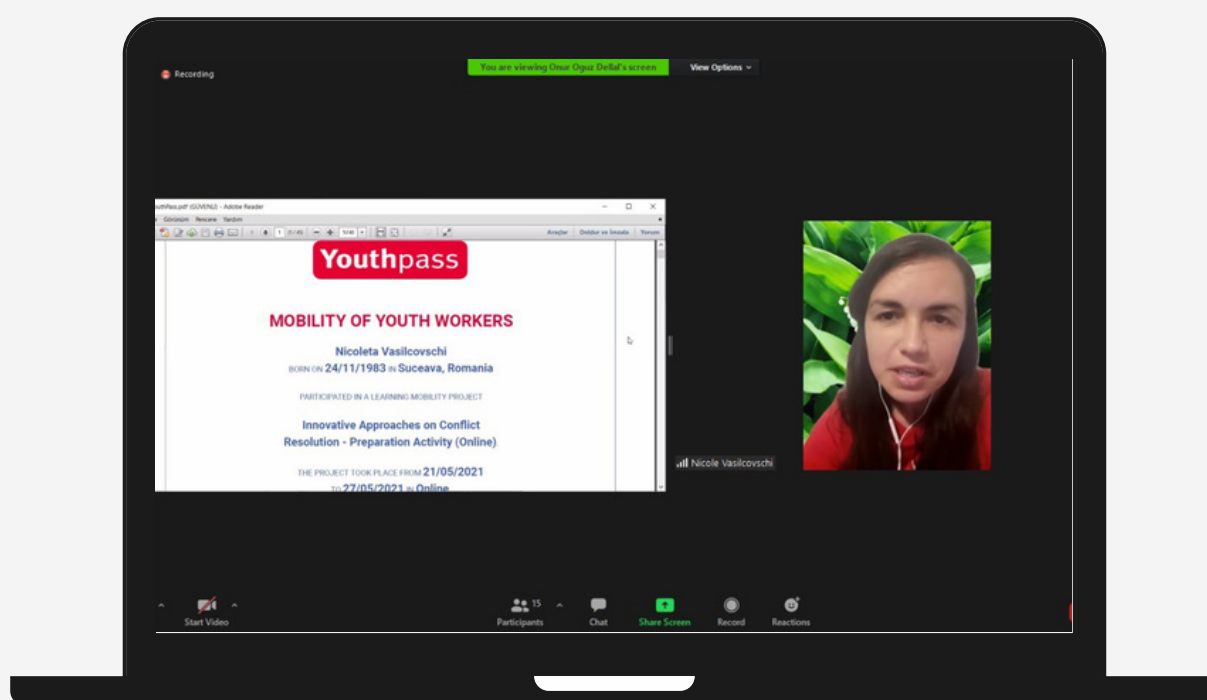
