The program of the project combines non-formal learning activities and mobility opportunities to enhance the knowledge, skills and competencies of participating young individuals.






MISSION

OBJECTIVES

- **Youth Empowerment:** Empower young individuals from diverse backgrounds with essential skills, knowledge, and tools for personal development and integration.
- **Social Inclusion:** Foster an inclusive society by promoting active engagement and collaboration between youth and local communities.
- **Non-Formal Learning:** Provide a dynamic learning environment through workshops, seminars, and interactive sessions that encourage experiential learning.
- **Cultural Exchange:** Facilitate cultural exchange and appreciation among participants, enhancing their understanding of different backgrounds and perspectives.
- **Community Engagement:** Encourage active participation in community initiatives, enabling youth to become positive contributors to their local environment.
- **Skills Development:** Equip participants with practical skills such as digital literacy, social entrepreneurship, and project management for personal and professional growth.

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- **Environmental Responsibility:** Promote ecological awareness and responsibility through activities emphasising sustainable practices and eco-consciousness.

- Identifying areas for improvement and future recommendations;
- Documenting project achievements and lessons learned.


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
